

TRANSFORMING LIVES FOOD BANK

This article covers three issues.

Firstly, the food bank is all about transforming lives, helping local people who are struggling to make ends meet. Sometimes it is difficult to admit there is a problem, but the food bank is here for you. The first step is to leave a message at mcfoffice@martockchristianfellowship.org, and we will contact you, probably on a Monday prior to a food parcel being ready on a Wednesday. Your details will be treated in confidence and your needs will be treated with the utmost importance.

Secondly, the Food Bank is looking for someone in Stoke sub Hamdon who has their ear to the ground and can help guide people struggling locally to the Food Bank and help us fulfil that person's needs. They would be the point of contact in Stoke that the Food Bank can look to for local advice. email us at mcfoffice@martockchristianfellowship.org to find out more. This would be so much appreciated.

Thirdly, if you want to give to the Food Bank, you can donate food at our very own Community Shop and this food will go directly to help anyone struggling to get by. If you want to give a financial donation, this can be done by standing order and this will enable us to purchase fresh produce locally, package it and have the parcel ready to be picked up. You can set up a standing order with your bank for MCF Transforming Liv, Sort code: 60-24-37 account number: 22670823, reference: Transforming Lives. Even better, if you are a tax payer, you can fill out the gift aid form so we can reclaim the tax of 25p for every £1 you give.
